Colossians 2:16-23 — Week 2: Christ and the Body

Week 1/July 30 - Christ—Substance or Shadow?
Week 2/August 6 - Christ and the Body- Tattoos? Food?
Week 3/August 13 - Christ and Resources- Tithe?
Week 4/August 20 - Christ and Time- Sabbath?

Reminders from Week 1

No one can judge you based on past “shadows”
No one can disqualify you based on their experiences
No one can force you to live in fear under worldly power/rules

*Pharisee Danger- Confusing Christian holiness with Victorian or mid-20th century values

*Prodigal Danger- Confusing Christian freedom with personal pride

***Only Christ brings spiritual power, fulfillment, and victory

-So...I can do anything I want? Or not?

-Does God care what I eat? What I put on my body?

How do we make decisions about things dealing with the body (food, tattoos, sex, etc.)?

1. Prescriptions- What Scriptures deal directly with my topic?
How do these verses fit within the scope of Scripture?
2. Patterns- What is the overall direction of Scripture?
How do we see the Bible's story unfolding?
3. Principles- What Gospel lessons do we learn from Scripture, even if the exact topic in Scripture is different from the question I'm addressing?

1 Corinthians 6:12-20

Other Scriptures to consider= Leviticus 19:28; Mark 7; Romans 14;
1 Corinthians 10:23-33; Ephesians 6:1-4; 1 Peter 2:12; 3:3-4

Key Pattern- “Everything we have is from God; everything we have is for God”

Key Principles- Stewardship; Holiness; Weak/Strong Faith; God's Glory; Evangelism

Response

-God, make me a good steward of the body you've given me
-God, call me to holiness in every aspect of life
-God, help me to live for the good of others, not myself
-God, use me for Your Glory and Your Kingdom. I am not my own; I was bought with a price. In my body, whether in sickness or health, I want to honor you in every way.

Gospel Core- Participating in the Lord's Supper

-The Cross = Christ gave His body for us
-The Resurrection = The body will be made new for Eternal Life
